Weekly Theme: “Community of Values”

Prayer Country: Tuvalu (Pacific Island) Christian 98%; Baha’i 1%; Other 1%

Monday, August 30—“The Lord’s Blessing”

Hearing: Read Numbers 6: 22-27

Examining: How is this blessing significant for us today?

Interceding: Pray for teachers/other school workers as many schools open this week.

Responding: Bless others around you; by doing so you are putting the name of God upon them.

Tuesday, August 31—“Blessed by the Father”

Hearing: Read Matthew 25: 31-40

Examining: Can the Lord of heaven look upon you and say, you are blessed of my Father? Why?

Interceding: Pray for all the children as they start a new school year.

Responding: Take time to be available for those who are listed in these verses.

Wednesday, September 1—“Wise and Foolish Builders”

Hearing: Read Matthew 7: 24-29

Examining: Where is your life built, on the rock or the sand?

Interceding: Seek a strong foundation through the Holy Spirit.

Responding: Be more involved in what the LORD has to offer, that way you will stand strong in times of storms.

Thursday, September 2—“Sincere Love”

Hearing: Read Romans 12: 9-13

Examining: On a scale from 1-10 how would you rate your love towards fellow believers?

Interceding: Ask for God’s kind of love.

Responding: Love with a love God has towards everyone, even those who may disagree with you.

Friday, September 3—“Right Response to Evil”

Hearing: Read Romans 12: 14-21

Examining: What is the reaction in these verses?

Interceding: Pray for our college students as many have started classes this week.

Responding: This can be an impossible task for us to handle, but the Holy Spirit in us makes this possible.

Saturday, September 4 – “Inheriting a Blessing”

Hearing: Read 1 Peter 3: 8-15

Examining: Are you willing to do good to those who insult? Why or why not?

Interceding: Ask the Holy Spirit to take control of your feelings so you will do the right thing.

Responding: Life is like a train, the engine is love, the caboose is feelings, the engine will run without the caboose.

Sunday, September 5—“Blessing for God’s People”

Hearing: Read Matthew 5: 1-16

Examining: Of all the beatitudes, which best describes you?

Interceding: Pray the Lord will show you where you belong.

Responding: Remain strong in your walk with Christ; the time is coming for these blessings to take hold.
