**Weekly Theme:** "Mission to the Community"

**Prayer Country:** Falkland Islands (South America) Christian 94.3%; Other 3.49%; non-Religious/other 2%; Baha'I 0.3%

### Monday, Mar. 1—Obedience to God's Call

**Hearing:** Read Matthew 21: 28-32

**Examining:** What is the lesson of the story that Jesus tells?

**Interceding:** Ask the Lord to help you say what you mean and mean what you say.

**Responding:** Your actions must match your words. Do they?

### Tuesday, Mar. 2—No Prophet Among Us

**Hearing:** Read Psalm 74

**Examining:** Why did Asaph think that God had rejected his people and grown angry?

**Interceding:** That God that he hears our cries for help!

**Responding:** When we feel devastated or forgotten, we can plead to God for help, knowing that he hears.

### Wednesday, Mar. 3—A Trustworthy Prophet

**Hearing:** Read 1 Samuel 3: 10-21

**Examining:** What did the Lord tell Samuel he was going to do to the house of Eli? Why?

**Interceding:** Before voicing your prayers, spend time listening to the Lord to hear what he is saying.

**Responding:** To receive God's messages, you must be ready to listen and act upon what he tells you.

Thursday, Mar. 4—A Prophet's Visions

Hearing: Read Numbers 12: 3-9

Examining: The Lord spoke "face to face" with Moses (v.8). Why was this a rebuke of Aaron and Miriam?

Interceding: Pray that you may have wisdom to understand the Lord's ways before you act foolishly.

Responding: Get rid of foolish ideas before they turn into foolish actions!

Friday, Mar. 5—A Prophet's Words

Hearing: Read Deuteronomy 18: 15-22

Examining: Who is the prophet that is spoken of in v.18? (See what Stephen says in Acts 7: 37.)

Interceding: Thank God that the coming of Jesus Christ was part of God's original plan.

Responding: Test all "prophecies" against the Bible. God never contradicts himself.

Saturday, Mar. 6—A Prophet's Prayer

Hearing: Read Jonah 2: 1-9

Examining: Take note of what you see in Jonah's prayer. Have you ever felt that way?

Interceding: Thank God that he hears you anywhere and at any time you pray.

Responding: Your predicament is never too difficult for God, so don't keep it from him!

Sunday, Mar. 7—A Prophet's Commission

Hearing: Read Jonah 1: 1-3, 3: 1-9

Examining: Why was Jonah given a second chance to participate in God's work?

Interceding: Thank God that he is the God of second chances: for Jonah, Ninevah, and you!

Responding: Remember that God has called you to be his witness no matter how unpopular it may be!
