**Weekly Theme:** “Shepherds Glorify God”

**Prayer Country:** Denmark (Europe) Christian 85.85%; non-Religious 11.0%; Muslim 3.02%; Jewish 0.13%

### Monday, December 13—“God’s Plan Fulfilled”

**Hearing:** Read Isaiah 46: 8-13

**Examining:** Will God’s plan succeed with or without you? What do you think?

**Interceding:** Pray that human emotions don’t discourage you from His plans.

**Responding:** To God we are like chess pieces; He has many options to go about his plan.

### Tuesday, December 14—“The King of Glory”

**Hearing:** Psalm 24

**Examining:** In reality we don’t own anything; it belongs to the creator. How do you feel about that?

**Interceding:** Give all you have unto the Lord; if you haven’t done so yet and watch what God does.

**Responding:** As Christians we shouldn’t want to possess anything. It is better to allow God to possess all we have.

### Wednesday, December 15 – “Who Is Like the Lord?”

**Hearing:** Read Psalm 113

**Examining:** “Who is like the Lord?”

**Interceding:** Praise God for there is no other.

**Responding:** No one is like the LORD, NO ONE! We are sinners saved through grace no more, no less.

**Thursday, December 16—“Praise the Lord”**

**Hearing:** Read Psalm 148

**Examining:** Praise the Lord all you who are down hearted and persecuted, praise him in good times as well as bad. Can you do this?

**Interceding:** Praise the LORD with all you have all the time.

**Responding:** Don't allow satan to steal your joy; anger him by praising the LORD continuously.

**Friday, December 17—“Glory Forever”**

**Hearing:** Read Romans 16: 25-27

**Examining:** Why is it important to give God the glory forever?

**Interceding:** Always give glory to the master of your life.

**Responding:** Man has done nothing to deserve any form of glory from God, only wrath, but thanks to Jesus the only one deserving of glory gave us salvation.

**Saturday, December 18 – “Mary’s First Baby”**

**Hearing:** Read Luke 2: 1-7

**Examining:** Do you have room for the savior or are there too many other things in life occupying you, leaving no room for the savior?

**Interceding:** Read Revelation 3: 20.

**Responding:** Let the Holy Spirit set your priorities that there will be no confusion (the Sunday school chorus J.O.Y. Jesus first, yourself last and others in between)!

**Sunday, December 19—“Glory to God”**

**Hearing:** Read Luke 2: 8-20

**Examining:** For unto you 2000 years ago a child was born the savior of mankind. Are you excited, or is seeing believing?

**Interceding:** Give praise and glory for the birth of a savior who was born 2000 years ago.

**Responding:** Sometimes it can be hard to give glory to God for the birth of Jesus because commercialism has removed the real focus of Christmas to a money making opportunity and the church sadly becomes involved or trapped.
